Deciding if a Commission is Right for You

Take a look at the attached price list to see if commissioning artwork is best the best option for you. I understand that custom art can be an investment, so if you wish to not proceed, no worries! Just let me know if you would like to move forward or not so I can update my available commission spots accordingly.

STEP 1: CHOOSE YOUR PHOTOS & MEDIUM

Selecting Photos: High-quality photos bring the best results. If you have a favorite photo in mind, let me know, or feel free to send a few for reference. Multiple angles or poses help capture all the important details.

Select a Medium: Choose between acrylic or watercolor paint, colored pencil, or graphite. Examples of each can be found on my website <u>www.kristindonnellyart.com</u>

STEP 2: PICK YOUR SIZE & MEDIUM

Sizing: Review the given price list & select a size that best fits your vision. Additional sizes are available by request.

Medium: For acrylic pieces, choose between a 1" thick canvas or heavyweight art paper. Colored pencil and graphite pieces are available only on art paper.

STEP 3: TIMELINE & PROCESS

Deadline Transparency: I complete commissions in my free time, so timelines can vary. Some pieces finish in a weekend, while others may take a few weeks. I'll keep you updated on timing and aim to complete your piece by your preferred deadline.

Progress Updates: I'm happy to send updates if you like, though many clients enjoy the final reveal as a surprise, so I don't send them automatically.
